RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF A CONTRACT FOR PROVIDING AS-NEEDED TRAFFIC SIGNAL MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR SERVICES FOR THE COUNTY OF SALEM, BID #26-20 (HIGH POINT HOME SERVICES, LLC - \$144,470.00)

WHEREAS, the Salem County Purchasing Agent, as authorized contracting Agent for the Salem County Board of Commissioners requested, received and opened sealed bids on Tuesday, August 25, 2026 at 11:00 AM prevailing time for Providing As-Needed Traffic Signal Maintenance and Repair Services for the County of Salem the receipt of said bids were duly advertised in accordance with the law and in such case made and provided; and

WHEREAS, bids were received as follows:

WHEREAS, all bid results are on file in the office of the Purchasing Agent, 110 Fifth Street, Suite 400 in the County of Salem New Jersey as required by law; and

WHEREAS, the Salem County Administration has reviewed the documents and recommends approval to High Point Home Services, LLC for this award; and

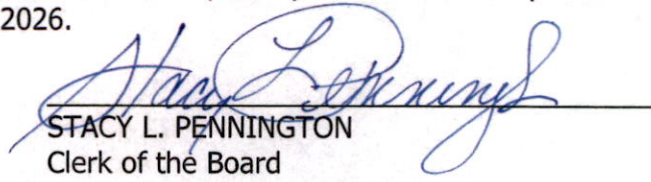
WHEREAS, no amount will be encumbered until such time as goods or services are ordered; and

WHEREAS, the Purchasing Agent and/or CFO/Treasurer, upon approving the release of a purchase order, shall ascertain that there are available sufficient uncommitted appropriations to provide payment.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Salem County Board of County Commissioners as follows:

1. The Salem County Board of County Commissioners hereby awards a contract for Providing As-Needed Traffic Signal Maintenance and Repair Services for the County of Salem to High Point Home Services, LLC the cost of which shall not exceed \$144,470.00, the term shall be for twelve (12) consecutive months commencing upon award by the governing body and terminating 8/31/2027, with (2) additional one (1) year extensions.
2. The Commissioner Director and Clerk of the Board shall be authorized to execute said contract upon compliance by the firm with all requirements and specifications.
